

SABIE GAME PARK CLIMATE

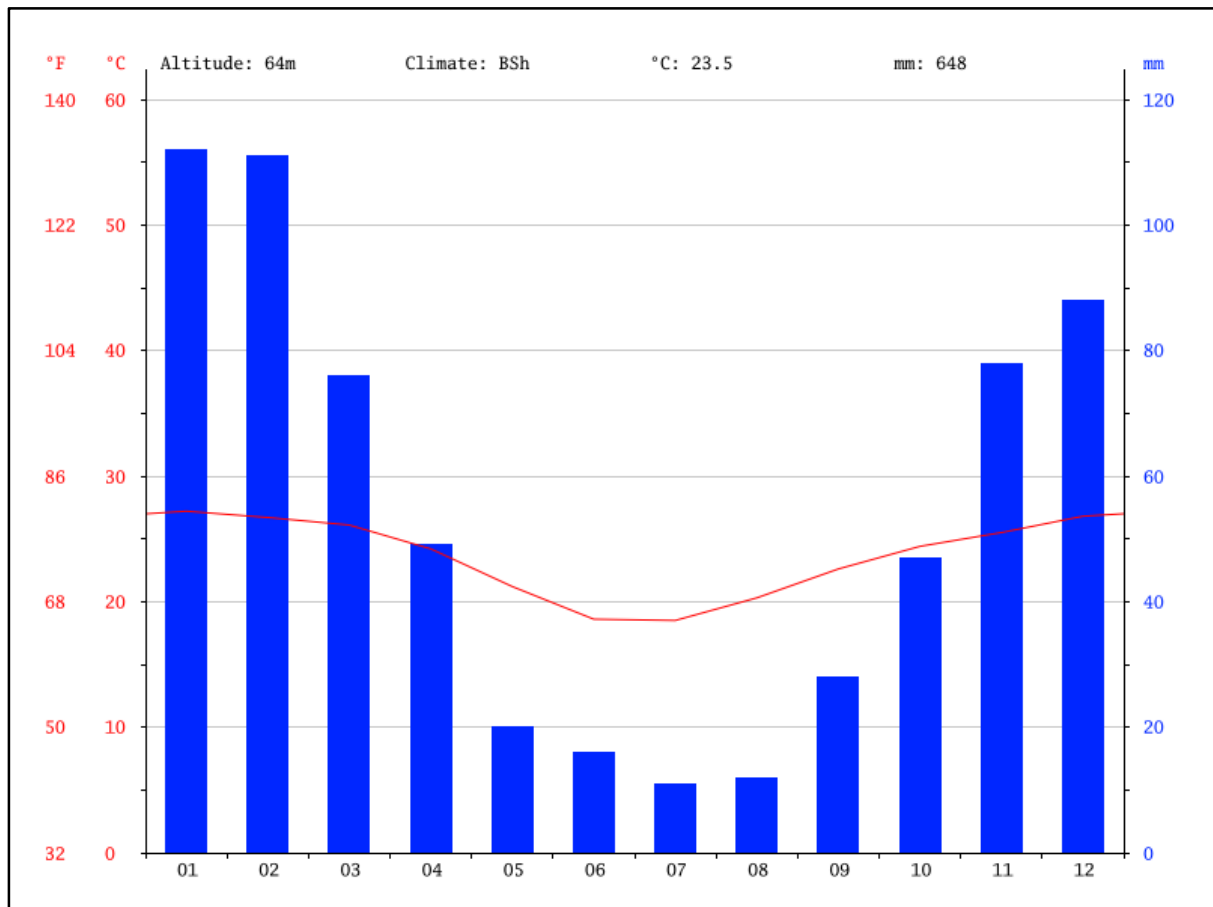
The region is a local steppe (semi-arid) climate according to the Köppen-Geiger climate classification. The average annual temperature is 23.5°C in Sabie and the average annual rainfall is around 648 mm. The summer rains start in October and finish in April, with December, January and February being the wettest months. The winter months are dry with the least amount of rain falling in July and August.

The summer months are warm to hot (averaging 27°C) and the sunny winter's days are generally warm (averaging 19°C). Maximum temperatures can reach into the 40s and the minimum temperatures can drop to around 10°C.

The African climate can change dramatically whatever the season. Staff are recommended to check weather reports before embarking on any activities with our guests, but guests should please ensure that they are suitably attired in "layered" clothing for hot or cold conditions. Should you be planning on spending the day in the sun, please ensure that you use sun screen.

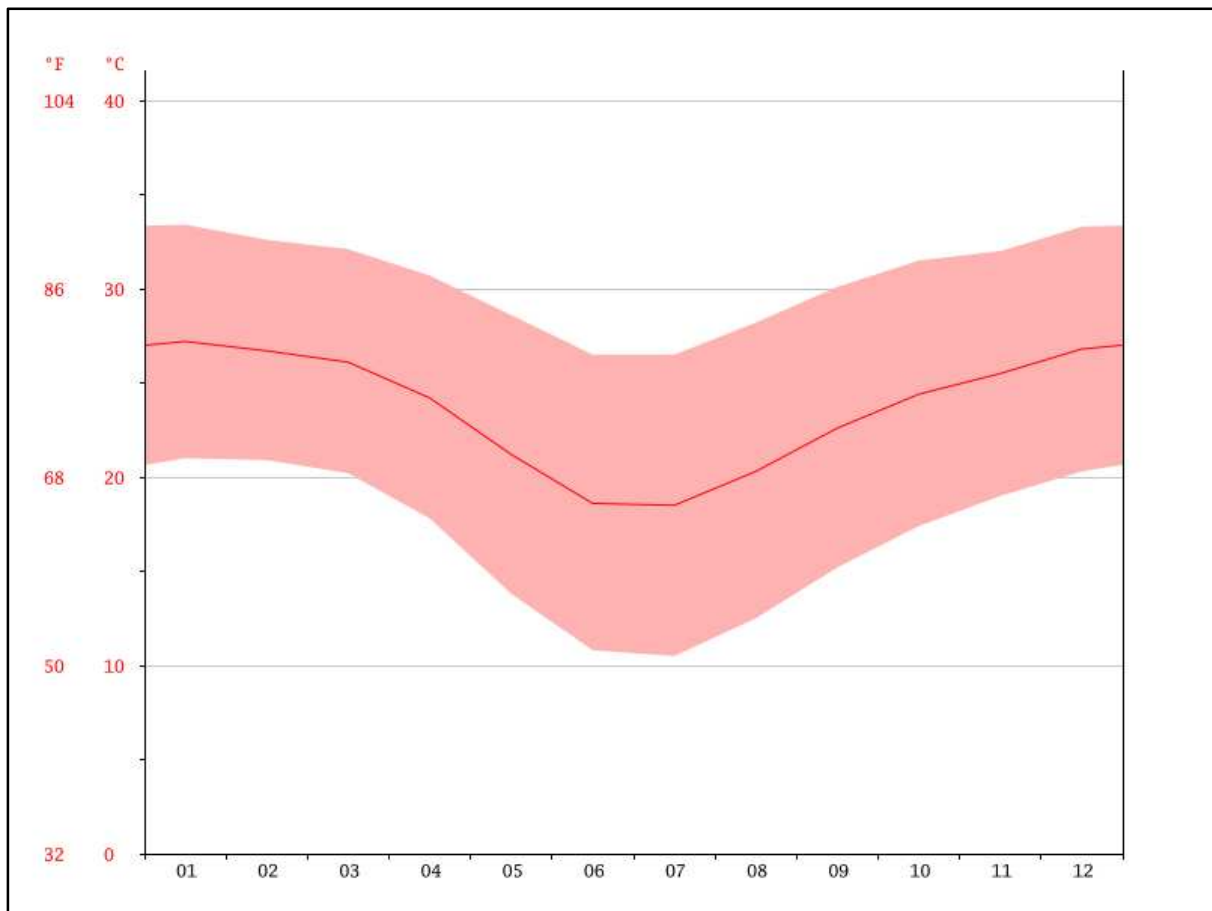

CLIMOGRAPH SABIE



Precipitation is the lowest in July, with an average of 11 mm. In January, the precipitation reaches its peak, with an average of 112 mm.

TEMPERATURE GRAPH SABIE



Between the driest and wettest months, the difference in precipitation is 101 mm. The variation in annual temperature is around 8.7 °C.
