DIRECTIONS TO SABIE GAME PARK – MOZAMBIQUE

From Komatipoort Border Post you take the EN4 road to Maputo and via versa from Maputo to the 251 road junction and head north past the town of Moamba and onto Corumana Dam.

1. From Gauteng you take the N4 via Mbombela (Nelspruit) to the Komatipoort / Lebombo Border Post.

Johannesburg to the Border: 445kms Pretoria to the Border: 430kms
Border to Sabie Game Park: 127km Maputo to Sabie Game Park: 140km

Maputo to Moamba town: 62kms

- 2. After clearing Customs you follow the EN4 towards Maputo.
- 3. 38kms after the border post you pass through a Tollgate. Travel a further 3kms and turn left to Moamba
- 4. 6kms later you will drive over a railway crossing into the town of Moamba. 1km later you come to a T junction in the town. Turn right and stay on the tar road. Follow the lane of trees out of town.
- 5. Follow this tar road which becomes a gravel road for 5kms. When the road splits, keep left and pass through a Tollgate. This is the road to Sabie town which crosses the Incomati River.
- 6. From the Tollgate you follow this dirt road for 31kms to the town of Sabie. Upon entering you find a disused Diesel depot on your right. Turn left onto the tar road to Corumana Dam.
- 7. Travel this road for 15kms until you have passed through a big settlement on your left. Continue straight ahead for another 500m and turn right onto a gravel road before you go up the hill and reach the water department boom gate and offices.
- 8. The dam wall will be on your left. Follow this road for just under 4kms and cross over the Sabie River Bridge.
- 9. About 100m from the bridge your turn sharp right at the tavern. Continue just over 1km. Soon after passing some big fig trees the road will turn sharply to your left.
- 10. From this turn follow the road for 8.5kms to a small village. From this point every time you see a green concrete block keep left.
- 11. From the first green block travel another 2km to the next green concrete block and keep left.
- 12. From the second concrete block travel another 5km and turn left at the third green concrete block. This is a well-defined track leading off the road you have been travelling.
- 13. From the third concrete block it is just over 6kms to the Sabie Game Park gate. This track will eventually lead to the reserve boundary fence and gate.
